



Federico Rubio and Emilio Rolán are well-known malacologists, who started working together already many years ago, their first joint paper dating 1991. From then on, they continued a fruitful collaboration, first studying the African malaco-fauna, and afterwards whit a number of revisions or different families, namely Skeneidae ant Tornidae, based on samples collected wordwide by the Paris MNHN; in all, they have published papers on the genus Clanculus in West Africa, followed by numeous others on Cornirostridae, Haplocochlias, Moerchia, Anticlimax, Parviturbo, Lophocochlias, in which new genera were described, among them Circuitus, Tuberes, Collatus, and also on Conradiidae. The authors have numerous projects they plan to pursue in the near future.
