

I. *Antopus*, N. A. Cobb, n. g.

Generic diagnosis: Enoplidae (Leptosomatinae): Cuticle unstriated. Cephalic setae six, others none, except pre- and post-anal on male. Pharynx none, no distinct lips or papillae. Oesophagus widening gradually, without bulb. Amphid not seen. Two dorso-sublateral rows of "pits" on neck. Tail tapering rapidly from anus, then gradually; swollen posteriorly. Caudal glands behind anus, filling base of tail. Vulva anterior, ovaries two, both doubly reflexed, the posterior much the longer. Spicula apparent! slender, gubernaculum a very small straight piece.

Type: *A. serialis* (Baylis, 1916) N. A. Cobb.

Synonym: *Stenolaimus serialis* Baylis, 1916.
