Dichromadora Kreis 1929

Teeth hollow, triangular, acute, not S-shaped; mostly one small to medium-sized dorsal tooth, and one or two small subventral teeth present; dorsal tooth rarely absent (*microdonta*). Amphids oval or ovally loop-shaped. Cuticular ornamentation homogeneous save the dots of some anterior rows which may be larger than the other ones, or fused; two longitudinal rows present. Esophageal bulb set off. Supplements present or absent.

Type: D. microdonta (?)

As already noted, species with an S-shaped dorsal tooth belong to Hypodontolaimus, e.g. D. geophila, and D. setosa.

I. Cephalic setae absent; esophageal bulb double:

D. gracilis (Kreis 1929)=Spilophorella g.
