

Halalaimus longicaudatus (Filipjev, 1927)
(Fig. 85F)

Description. Body length 2.0 mm. Maximum diameter 26 μm ($a = 75$). Four posterior cephalic setae shorter than but situated close to the six 0.9 h.d. long anterior cephalic setae. Amphids 48 μm long, about 3.5 times distance from anterior end of body. Tail long and tapering to a fine tip.

Distribution. Northumberland (fine sublittoral sand).




Fig. 85. *Halalaimus gracilis*. A, Male head; B, Male tail; C, Entire male; D, Spicules and gubernaculum. Original. E-H, Diagrammatic representations of head and male tail of E, *H. gracilis*, F, *H. longicaudatus*, G, *H. isaitshikovi*, H, *H. capitulatus*.
