


Fig. 103. Nannolaimus fusus. A, Entire male; B, Male head; C, Region of oesophageal bulb; D, Male tail; E, Cloacal region. Original.

## Nannolaimus fusus Gerlach, 1956 (Fig. 103)

Description. Body length 1.2 mm. Maximum diameter 19  $\mu$ m (a = 66). Cuticle with transverse rows of small dots, but without lateral differentiation. Lateral file of cuticle pores (Fig. 103D). Labial sensilla 3.5  $\mu$ m. Six 11  $\mu$ m and four 6  $\mu$ m cephalic setae situated almost at the same level. Amphids in male large, of 6.5 turns, longitudinally elongated, 18  $\mu$ m long and 11  $\mu$ m (0.9 c.d.) wide; female amphid unknown. Buccal cavity narrow with a small, weakly cuticularised dorsal tooth (Fig. 103B). Tail 6 a.b.d.

Spicules 26  $\mu$ m (1.4 a.b.d.) with a central lamella throughout most of their length (Fig. 103E). Ten precloacal supplements.

Distribution. South Bay, North East Ireland (intertidal sand).
