


Fig. 117. Paracanthonchus thaumasius. A, Male head; B, Amphid; C, Male tail; D, Detail of third supplement from cloaca; E, Cloacal region. Original.

Paracanthonchus thaumasius (Schulz, 1932) (Fig. 117)

Description. Body length 1.6–1.9 mm. Maximum diameter 36–45 μ m (a = 42–45). Similar to *P. platti* (p. 258) except: amphids 4.5–5.5 turns, 10–11 μ m (0.3–0.4 c.d.) wide and only occupying six cuticle annules; subventral teeth in buccal cavity weakly developed.

Distribution. Firth of Clyde, West Scotland; Strangford Lough, North East Ireland, recorded as P. tyrrhenicus (intertidal sand).
