


Fig. 52. Prochromadorella attenuata. A, Entire male; B, Male head; C, Cloacal region of male; D, E, Lateral cuticle at base of oesophagus and caudal region respectively. From Lorenzen (1972a).

Prochromadorella attenuata (Gerlach, 1952) (Fig. 52)

Description. Very similar to P. septempapillata except: body shorter (1.0-1.1 mm) and plumper (a = 24-32); lateral cuticle lacks the large dots in the anterior oesophageal region; distal tip of gubernaculum double. It is perhaps debatable whether this and the previous species are distinct, and a more critical comparison of material may show that they are synonymous.

Distribution. Isles of Scilly (intertidal sand).
