5. Rhabdodemania nom. nov.

Syn. Demania Southern, 1914, nec Laurie, 1906, nec Steiner, 1914.

Cuticle smooth. Head with ten bristles in one or two crowns. Lateral organs indistinct. Pharynx large and deep, the hinder portion having three longitudinal chitinoid rods, each with an anterior tooth. All the teeth are apparently of equal size. Oesophagus slightly swollen posteriorly. Caudal end of male without preanal papillae or supplementary organs. Spicules equal. An accessory piece present. Female genital tubes paired, opposed, reflexed. Caudal glands present.

Hab. Marine.
