

S. antarctica Cobb, 1914: juveniles only described; considered doubtful by Wieser (1954).

S. arctica (Allgén, 1954): poor figure **Dub. nov.**

S. arcuata Wieser, 1954: based on single damaged specimen. **Dub. nov.**

S. australis Allgén, 1929: based on juveniles only; considered dubious by Platt (1983).

S. cettensis Rouville, 1903: considered doubtful by Filipjev (1922) and Wieser (1954).

S. cleopatris Micoletzky, 1924: ♀♀ only, no figure. **Dub. nov.**

S. filicaudata Allgén, 1951: considered doubtful by Wieser (1954).

S. heterospiculum Allgén, 1953: considered dubious by Platt (1983).

S. heterura (Cobb, 1898) *nec* Wieser 1954, no illustration. **Dub. nov.**

S. jubata Cobb, 1898: insufficient description. **Dub. nov.**

S. kolaensis (Saweljev, 1912): no illustration. **Dub. nov.**

S. mawsoni Wieser, 1954 *pro S. antarctica* (Cobb, 1930): poor figure. **Dub. nov.**

S. norwegica Allgén, 1931: considered *incertae sedis* by Wieser (1954) **Dub. nov.**

S. paravulgaris Filipjev, 1946: ♀ only. **Dub. nov.**

S. pellucida Allgén, 1959: ♀ only. **Dub. nov.**

S. rotundicauda Allgén, 1959: ♀ only. **Dub. nov.**

S. taboguillensis (Allgén, 1947): considered insufficiently described by Wieser (1954). **Dub. nov.**

S. tenuicaudata (Bastian, 1865): insufficient description; considered dubious by Wieser (1954).

S. tenuiseta Allgén, 1959: ♀ only; considered *inquirenda* by Jensen (1979a). **Dub. nov.**

S. tubilaima Allgén, 1959: ♀ only; considered *inquirenda* by Jensen (1979a). **Dub. nov.**
