


Fig. 228. Tricoma brevirostris. A, Male head; B, Entire male; C, Cloacal region; D, Male tail tip. From Southern (1914).

Tricoma brevirostris (Southern, 1914) (Fig. 228)

Description (from Southern, 1914). Body length 0.6 mm. Maximum diameter $36 \,\mu\text{m}$ (a = 16). 78 desmen. Cephalic setae 0.8 h.d. Head triangular with thickened cuticular walls.

Spicules curved, cloaca between desmen 68 and 69. Gubernaculum with dorsal apophysis.

Distribution. Clew Bay, West Ireland, single male (sublittoral sand and shells).
