Calanella, diminutive of Calanus.

Body elongate and narrow: anterior part of head slender; moderately elongate, with a triangular frontal prominence: thorax seg'ts fused, indistinct. 1^o antennae 23-jointed, joints 1+2, and 8+9, fused, basal joint very long = not geniculate in ♂. armed with coarse appendages. Secondary ramus of 2^o antennae short - 8-jointed. mandibular palps greatly elongate, primary ramus very short - Inferior maxill. very long and stout, legs rudimentary, lacking in ♀, in ♂ uniramous and prehensile - eyes simple, small; abdomen short, in ♂ 4-jointed (5^o seg't fused with furca.
