

Cyclopoidea - Chordeumidae.

Chordeuma = synonym.

Jungersen, 1914.

C. obesum <sup>(M)</sup>.

Not Chordeuma - Kock - 1847 - Myriapod.

Χορδέυμα, a sausage.

Changed to Chordeumium Stephensen,  
(Mortensen & Stephensen, 1918, p. 268).

Body made up of a head, cephalon, 4 thoracic segments, and an unsegmented abdomen. The head region carries 3 pairs of appendages, first and antennae and maxillae, with no traces of mandibles or first maxillae or eyes.

First antennae short, clumsy and unsegmented, with two blunt terminal processes; second antennae far behind the first, unsegmented.

Four pairs of short, unsegmented legs with weak claws. No intestine in abdomen; no anus.
