Κόγχη = Shell and χήρης = bereft.

Body elongated, tapered, 2 divisions sharply separated; head protuberant laterally; tail in both sexes 4-jointed. First antennae 6-jntd. in ♂ with many aesthetascs. 2nd. antennae short and stout. Posterior mxpds. absent in ♀ but well developed and prehensile in ♂. All the rami 3-jointed; last legs made up of a single joint with 3 setae.
