Body nearly circular; cephalic and thoracic
segts. produced laterally into points.
Abdomen of ♀ 3-jointed; first antennae 17-joint-
ed; second antennae as in *Asterocheres*.
Mandible, maxilla and mxpds. and first 4 pairs
of legs as in *Asterocheres*. 5th. legs with
only two joints.
