Body depressed: rostrum long, turned ventrally. 10 segt fused with head and armed with spines in transverse rows: 2°, 3°, and 4° segts. also with 1-2 cross rows of spines: abdomen with 3-4 cross rows.  
10 anten. 6-jointed: 2° ant. 2-jointed with a 1-segmented exopod. Ex. of all legs 3-jointed  
En. 2-jointed: 30 pair in male hbs 3-jointed  
Endopod - 50 legs 2-jointed, basal joints with outer enlargement.
