Idya = synonym.

Syn. of Tisbe, Willjeborg

Idya was used by Fréminville for a genus of Acalephs in 1809 and Idyia by Rafinesque for a genus of Crustacea in 1814. Hence it must yield its precedence to Tisbe. - Sars proposed Idyaea in 1911.

Body depressed: epimeral plates of 1^o
three segts. broad, lamellar: last segt.
of metasome very small - 1^o antennae
8-jointed, subprehensile in ♂. Exopod
of 2^o antennae 4-jointed - Both rami of
1^o legs 3-jointed, endopod much longer
than exopod - 5^o legs slender, extended
laterally -
