Head distinct, somewhat quadrilateral: thorax
elongated & composed of 4 rings, indistinctly ar-
ticulated. Gen. segts short. Abdomen very
long and narrow: anal appendages small, lobe-
like. Anterior antennae 10-jointed: post. pair
not uncinata but setiferous.

First mxpds. very large & stout, ending in a strong
claw = second pair smaller - ending in 3 claws.

Five pairs of rudimentary thorax legs - 1st two near
head & close together, others farther apart.

First 4 pairs biramous: rami 1-jointed: 5th
pair minute and stump-like.
