Macrobrachius. Ergasilidae.

μακρὸς = long : βραχίων = arm.

Genus Diagnosis. Male unknown.

Female, Body elongated, narrow, formed. Four thorax joints and 4 abdominal joints. Carapace large, narrow, cut in form of a semicircle - Other joints diminishing in size backwards. Abdomen cylindrical, anal laminae divergent, tipped with spines and a long, narrow tube.

Antennae slender, short, many jointed, hairy.

Eye double, near v anterior border, on v dorsal surface.

Second antennae very long, reaching v tip of 3rd thorax ring.

Mouth at v post' extremity of head, median, pyriform.

Feet biramous, rami 3-jointed - joined across v center

body by a transverse rib.

Eggs large, in fusiform cases.
