SYNONYMY.

Head rounded in front, with 2 pairs of antennae and lateral lobes; produced posteriorly as a cylindrical neck; mouth at junction of neck with thorax; mandibles, 1 pair maxillae, mxpds. Thorax divided, anterior part with 2 pairs rudimentary legs, 1-segd, and 2 pairs lateral processes, posterior part with 1 pair antero, 1 pair medio, 1 pair postero-lateral processes. Abdomen minute, 1-segd. Male a pygmy, head fused with first 2 segts, 3rd, 4th, and 5th segts free; abdomen 1-segd. 2 pairs antennae, mds, mx, mxpds, 2 pairs legs caudal rami.
