Prefix Para and Lichomolcus.

Body composed of 10 seg'ts.; cephalothorax rotund or ovate, 5-jointed; gen. seg't. much larger than the others, really 2 seg'ts. united. 1st. antennae 8-jointed. 2nd. antennae, mouth-parts and legs as in *Lichomolgus*, the difference being in the lateral prolongations of the body seg'ts. and in the jointing of the 1st. antennae
