Carapace rounded, shield-shaped: frontal plates with lunules. Genital seg't. of large size and covered with 2 large dorsal plates. abdomen also with 2 elongated flattened processes projecting backward from its base. Fourth segment free, without plates or processes - First and fourth swimming legs uniramous - second + third biramous. anal laminae small, with short setae.
