πλατύς, wide and thorax.

Body large and squat. Carapace rounded, followed by 3 superimposed joints and then a lateral enlargement for the eggs, between which is the abdomen, narrow, 5- or 6-jointed, followed by flat appendages of medium size armed with divergent hairs. Antennae slender, with many hairs. Eye in the center of the frontal border. Thorax segts, turned down slightly at their margin. Swimming legs biramose.
