Pseudo and Chondracanthus.

Head distinctly separated from rest of body covered with dorsal carapace. 1st thorax seg't. only free - others fused into gen. seg't. leaving no traces of seg'ts. Abdomen small 2-jointed. 2nd antennae stout hooks - mouth-parts at post. margin of head - like sickle-shaped - toothed along both margins. Maxillae very large and attached to extreme lateral margins, giving cheeks a swollen appearance. When open they expose v whole front face. A single pair of swimming legs - bilobed at tips.
