Pseudo and clavella

Head small, rounded. A single free thorax segment without lobes or dorsal plates. Genital segment oval, four times as long as cephalothorax. Abdomen very short. Anal laminae minute, setiferous. First antennae indistinctly 3-jointed; second pair short, uncinata. Second mxpds. slender. Four pairs of rudimentary legs present, the first two biramous, 3rd. and 4th. from gen. seg't & stump-like.
