Body medium, anterior division fusiform; gen. segt. in ♀ scarcely subdivided. Caudal rami sub-lamellar. First antennae in ♀ 7-jointed first 2 much larger than the others; second pair elongated and prehensile. Maxillae with slender accessory masticatory lappet. Base of 1st. mxpds. large and massive; 2nd. pair very different in two sexes. Both rami 3-jointed in all the legs.
