Sagum, a military cloak, alluding to  
the shape of the fused dorsal plates  
covering the thorax.

Gen. body form similar to Ternanthropus.  
Cephalothorax irregular in outline: antennal  
area separated from head by marginal sinuses.  
Posterior body covered with a single dorsal  
plate, prolonged at post' corners into large  
lobes. Antennae & mouth-parts similar to those  
in Ternanthropus - 1<sup>o</sup> and 2<sup>o</sup> legs reduced  
to 1-jointed processes, bipartite at tip: 3<sup>o</sup>  
leg with broad & laminate endopod: rami of 4<sup>o</sup>  
legs laminate at base, flagellate at tips &  
5<sup>o</sup> & gen. seg 15. and abdomen reduced and  
concealed: anal laminate short -
